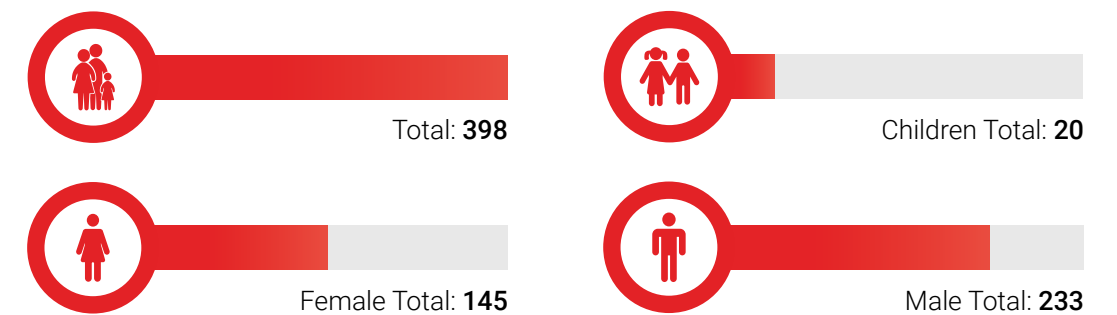


# SOUTH GUJARAT INDIA

More than 32 million people in India have been affected by COVID. While COVID has impacted families in different ways across the globe, people at-risk of dying are those who live in remote areas due the inability to access healthcare.

To address the crisis, HCI initiated a special project to provide at-home care to COVID19 patients living in the rural villages of South Gujarat. Some of the patients were moved to the COVID19 isolation centre at Kosadi Village for a period of 15 days for treatment. In the cases where the patients had serious respiratory issues, they were admitted into the nearest hospital, and their treatment cost was covered by HCI.
