Crisis communities struggle to access healthcare professionals in their most urgent time of need. Whether it's the elderly or the injured, sick children or pregnant women, access to healthcare is a requirement for well-being, and HCI is there to provide it.

We have funded mobile health clinics to service pockets of internally displaced Syrians spread out across multiple camps. We've also funded healthcare programs for mothers and newborns in Turkiye to reduce the mortality rate. Additionally, HCI supported refugee communities in Jordan with their mental healthcare needs. Services included rehab, psychosocial therapy, speed therapy and more.

Over 32,398 people thank our donors and supporters for providing crisis communities access to physical and mental healthcare services.

Unsanitary water is the leading cause of disease and sickness in communities worldwide. Estimates have it that 1000 children die each day from waterborne diseases. It also has an impact on school attendance. Each year, children miss 443 million school days from water-related challenges.

HCI reaches the remotest communities to provide families and children with access to clean water. With clean water, families are healthy, children stay in school, and economies develop. Without clean water, communities will continuously suffer.




Our donors' support means that a child has the opportunity to climb out of poverty and lead a positive, autonomous, dignified life for themselves and their families. The potential impact is generations-long.

The Child Sponsorship Program (CSP) fills the vacuum a deceased parent leaves, allowing children to escape poverty and realize their dreams. Without a CSP program to support such children, they fall victim to exploitation, violence, abuse, and poverty.

HCI's Child Sponsorship Program provides each child with fundamental rights such as education, healthcare, food and water, clothing, and stability.

Through the generous support of our donors, 3,454 children have had their safety and security restored, their futures illuminated, and their frowns turned to smiles.


